YouthSpeak Forum AIESEC

(Dutch only)

In samenwerking met AIESEC Nederland organiseert AIESEC in Nijmegen 14 maart een YouthSpeak Forum; op nationaal niveau wordt op één dag aan meer dan 2.000 leerlingen lesgegeven. Een YouthSpeak Forum is een event dat leiders samenbrengt om jongeren te inspireren over dringende mondiale problemen. Het forum heeft tot doel een omgeving te creëren waar jongeren met verschillende achtergronden inzichten kunnen delen en nieuwe perspectieven kunnen verkrijgen die de wereld vooruit helpen. AIESEC brengt leerlingen vandaag bij elkaar door middel van UNICEF's World's Largest Lesson. Alle kinderen denken vandaag na over welke structurele veranderingen zij in hun leven kunnen doorvoeren om positief bij te dragen aan het behalen van de doelen voor 2030; minder lang douchen, minder vlees eten, meelopen met de Women's March en maandelijkse donaties aan goede doelen.

Het event start met een keynote van Gerjo Schepers, werkzaam bij Rabobank Rijk van Nijmegen. Hierin wordt kort het belang verteld van de Duurzame Ontwikkelingsdoelen voor de bedrijfsvoering van Rabobank. Vervolgens wordt er inzicht gegeven in hoe de dag eruit ziet: ervaringen worden gedeeld, instructies worden ingezicht en de studenten oefenen alvorens zij workshops gaan geven. Bij het Mondial College, Nijmegen-West krijgen in totaal 174 scholieren les krijgen over de Ontwikkelingsdoelen van de Verenigde Naties. Deze dag draagt bij aan het onderwerp van duurzaamheid, een onderwerp waar "Green Capital" Nijmegen vandaag de dag zeer bij betrokken is.
